ADMISSION TO ST. PETER'S HIGH SCHOOL IN SEPTEMBER 2017

The admission procedure is now under way for current Year 6 pupils. St Peter's High School no longer requires parents to complete an information form. However, they do require a copy of either your child's baptismal certificate or first Holy Communion certificate to be given directly to them. The closing date for both the local authority common application form (to be completed online unless a paper copy has been requested from the local authority) and the documentation for the high school is 31^{st} October 2016. Tours of the school run from Monday 3^{rd} October to Thursday 6^{th} October and commence at 10.30am and 1.50pm and there is open an open evening on Wednesday 5^{th} October from 6.30pm until 8pm, with the headteacher will address parents at 6.45pm and 8.00pm.
