MAKING A DIFFERENCE

Following Pope Francis' call to us to celebrate the Year of Mercy last year, Bishop Declan has asked all schools in the Clifton Diocese to continue to focus on the acts of mercy under the theme of 'Make A Difference'. In Assembly this week we reflected on the acts of mercy (feed the hungry; give drink to the thirsty; clothe the naked; shelter the homeless; visit the sick; visit the imprisoned; bury the dead) and I was really impressed with the children's knowledge and understanding of these acts — especially some very profound explanations about 'visit the imprisoned' by our Y6 pupils. In the coming weeks our school Chaplaincy Reps will meet to decide which act of mercy we will focus on so that we can 'make a difference' to others in the world. There are so many ways to show mercy — be compassionate, show love, show forgiveness, be gently, put the needs of others before your own needs. Please think about this at home and praise your child when he/she shows mercy.
