CORE VALUES

The first core value this year is CREATIVITY - we shine when we appreciate creativity. The children will be learning that God was the creator of the world in which we live. The core value will encourage the children to use all their senses to explore the beauty in the world around them and consider ways in which people celebrate God's creation – such as through painting, photography or making music – and the way in which a person has chosen to do this is an expression of their own creativity. We will also look at how we all have a responsibility to take care of the world around us in order to maintain its beauty.

Your child has brought home a core value certificate. Please return the certificate to school when your child has demonstrated the core value of CREATIVITY at home.

GOOD TO BE GREEN (GTBG) BEHAVIOUR SYSTEM

On Friday 8th September children in Years 1 to 6 were introduced to this year's GTBG behaviour reward system. The reward this year will be coloured bookmarks which will be a different colour each term - red, orange, yellow, green, blue and violet.

We recognise that, from time to time, children may make the wrong choice and therefore a child will still receive a termly reward (the appropriate coloured bookmark) if they remain green for the term or if they have received one or two amber warning cards in that term.

If a child has stayed 'green' (i.e. has not received any amber or red cards) all academic year then s/he will be awarded a special bookmark at the end of the school year. The School Council will choose the final design in the summer term.

This new system was effective from Monday 11th September. Therefore, any children who received an amber or red card prior to this date were given a fresh start on Monday so that they can aspire to receiving a red bookmark.

Children in RJB and RAE will spend the Autumn terms settling in and understanding the language of the behaviour system. They will join the reward system in January 2018. A letter will go out to parents of children in RJB and RAE once the behaviour system has been introduced to the children.
