A FUTURE FULL OF HOPE

Bishop Declan has written and published a booklet entitled 'A Future Full of Hope' in which he sets out his vision for our Diocese. The vision is a 3 year one and is symbolised by an anchor – an ancient symbol of hope. The image of the anchor does not promise protection from the storm or free us from the battering waves but it gives us the reassurance that the Lord is with us. The Bishop's vision focuses on the person and mission of Jesus Christ. Bishop Declan calls us to encounter the Lord Jesus anew in Mission, Prayer and Communion. So in this liturgical year (Dec 2017 – Nov 2018) the focus is MISSION and Mark's Gospel. Ask your children if they remember which part of the anchor represents MISSION (ANSWER: It is the cross!)
