#### **The Fourth Sunday of Advent**

On Sunday, the priest will light the fourth candle, the 'CANDLE OF LOVE' which symbolizes Christ's love for us. The lighting of this last purple candle also reminds us that our preparation for Christmas is almost finished. Today we remember Mary's great act of selflessness and devotion to God. We thank her for becoming the mother of Jesus and for sharing her Son with the world. The final candle on the advent wreath (the white one) will be lit on **Christmas day** – this candle celebrates Jesus as the light of the world – when we rejoice at the birth of our Lord and Saviour. We give thanks to God for the gift of Jesus.

# **CORE VALUES**

As part of learning about democracy and how to vote, children in years one to six voted for the core value they wanted to be in focus next term. The results are: Courage – 104, Wisdom – 88, Perseverance – 85 and Service - 52. There were 11 spoilt ballot papers.

Therefore, our Core Value next term will be COURAGE – we shine when we show courage. Courage and bravery are ideas we often hear about, but they are usually linked to some dramatic act of heroism. It is much rarer that courage and bravery are related to the ordinary life experiences of ordinary people – and even rarer the ordinary experiences of children. Next term we will help the children to recognise that true courage is not only heroic acts in extremely unusual situations but may be the simple fact of surviving through difficult circumstances each and every day or facing the challenges and opportunities that each new day brings with determination, hope, optimism and bravery.



## GOOD TO BE GREEN (GTBG) BEHAVIOUR SYSTEM
