We're pleased to tell you that Caterlink have agreed to reduce the children's meal price from January to £2.32 per day, or £11.60 per week.

Please could we ask that you keep your ParentPay account in credit at all times in order to purchase a school meal.

Your child might be eligible for free school meals, and you can easily check this by following this link:

https://www.gloucestershire.gov.uk/education-and-learning/school-transport-and-free-school-meals/apply-for-free-school-

meals/. You will just need an email address and your National Insurance or National Asylum Support

Service (NASS) number to hand, and you will receive an instant response once you have completed the claim. You can still apply using a paper form but the response will not be as quick.



SchoolPing SCHOOLPING

Some parents are not getting the notification of new messages and are having to sign in each time. To solve this, sign in to the SchoolPing app as usual. Press the top left hand menu button and choose 'Settings'. Then choose 'Inactivity lockout settings' and press on the slider button to turn it off. This means that you will then always be logged in to your SchoolPing account so you should receive notifications. Please note it also means there will be no timeout. You could also check that 'Notifications' are on, in general 'Settings' on your phone. If you have any issues with this, please come to the office.
