THE THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

"Rejoice: The Lord is nigh!" As Christmas draws near, the Church emphasises the joy which should be in our hearts over all that the birth of our Saviour means for us. The great joy of Christians is to see the day drawing near when the Lord will come again in His glory to lead them into His kingdom. The oft-repeated Veni ("Come") of Advent is an echo not only of the prophets but also of the conclusion of the Apocalypse of St. John: "Come, Lord Jesus." the last words of the New Testament.

This third Sunday of Advent is known as Gaudete Sunday. The term Gaudete refers to the first word of the Entrance Antiphon, "Rejoice". Rose vestments are worn to emphasise our joy that Christmas is near, and we also light the rose candle on our Advent wreath.

ParentPay MEAL PRICE

I'm pleased to tell you that the Caterlink have agreed to reduce the children's meal price from January to £2.32 per day, or £11.60 per week. Please keep your ParentPay account in credit.

Your child might be eligible for free school meals, and you can easily check this by following this link:

You will just need an email address and your National Insurance or National Asylum Support

Service (NASS) number to hand, and you will receive an instant response once you have completed the claim. You can still apply using a paper form but the response will not be as quick.



SchoolPing SCHOOLPING: IMPORTANT ADVICE – PLEASE FOLLOW THIS TO ENSURE YOU GET ALL

COMMUNICATIONS FROM SCHOOL

Some parents are not getting the notification of new messages and are having to sign in each time. To solve this, sign in to the SchoolPing app as usual. Press the top left hand menu button and choose 'Settings'. Then choose 'Inactivity lockout settings' and press on the slider button to turn it off. This means that you will then always be logged in to your SchoolPing account so you should receive notifications. Please note it also means there will be no timeout. You could also check that 'Notifications' are on, in general 'Settings' on your phone. If you have any issues with this, please come to the office.
