## **ASH WEDNESDAY & LENT**

Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent, the season of repentance and preparation for the resurrection of Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday. We started our Lenten journey by receiving ashes on Ash Wednesday. The ashes remind us that we are sinners and that we were made from dust which is why the priest says, "You are made from dust and unto dust you shall return." During Lent we think of the importance of forgiving and forgiveness. We also focus on the 3 pillars of Lent: Prayer, Fasting and Giving. The children know that if they give up chocolate/crisps/fizzy drinks that this is a form of fasting. During our Ash Wednesday service the Y5 children provided a book for all in our school community to add their prayers to and the children also reminded us of the importance of giving to those in need. As we start our Lenten journey, we ask you to talk to your children about the importance of making and keeping a Lenten promise.

As part of the world book day theme - 'Share a Story', on Monday your child should come home with a reading star challenge sheet. 


#### **RAGS 2 RICHES 4 SCHOOLS COLLECTION**
