### WELCOME BACK

Monday was a truly joyous day for us as we started to welcome some of our Reception, Year 1, Year 6, Keyworker and vulnerable children back to school. It was wonderful to see the excitement on their faces as they came through the school gates. These children have had to get used to a new way of working and playing while keeping their distance and I have to say they have adapted really quickly. Well done, children! We are all very proud of you!

Of course we know that children in Y2, Y3, Y4 and Y5 can't return just yet but I wanted to reiterate my previous message to all these children so I have copied the information sent before and would be really grateful to all parents if you could share this with them again:

*I would be very grateful to parents/carers if you could spend some time with your child/children explaining the situation to them. It is important that the children understand that because of social distancing, it is not safe or possible for everyone to return to school at once. Year groups that are not yet able to come back are no less important, special or loved, it is just that we have to start somewhere. The Government **aims** to have all children back at school before the summer holidays although details of this are currently not finalised. In the meantime, we will continue to offer home learning via our website. Responses to the 2Dos on the Purple Mash might be from a different teacher if your teacher is teaching a class in school.*
