#### **CORONAVIRUS**

Please note that a runny nose is NOT a coronavirus symptom, and if your child is feeling well in themselves they can come to school. Now we are all in school, there are the inevitable sneezes and sniffles which may cause some confusion – you know your child, but if you are not sure about any symptoms your child is showing, please use the <a href="NHS online covid symptom checker">NHS online covid symptom checker</a>. Alternatively, you can call 111, but please note that they are very busy.

If you have children in other settings – secondary school, nursery etc, where you have not sent them in because of coronavirus symptoms, OR they have been sent home with suspected coronavirus symptoms, you should arrange a test for them, and the rest of your household MUST isolate for 14 days, or until you have received the test results. This includes not sending ANY of the children in your household to school or nursery during this period. Please refer to the <u>guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus infection</u>. Tests should only be booked for those with symptoms. Please would you let school know the result. If the test comes back as negative then the household can return to work and school if everyone is feeling well. If you have been unable to book a test, the isolation periods have passed (10 days for the person with symptoms, 14 days for everyone else) and everyone is feeling well, the household can return to work and school.

We are grateful that parents follow these government guidelines as it helps to keep us all safe and stop the spread of coronavirus.

This week and next week, all teachers will be talking to their class about Stranger Danger. we would encourage all parents to also talk to your children about Stranger Danger so that they know what to do if they ever found themselves in an uncomfortable situation. Our messages in school are,

- never speak to a stranger
- 2. don't accept sweets or any items from a stranger
- 3. if someone in a car calls you over do not go
- 4. if you don't feel safe yell and run away
- 5. run towards a shop/busy place and tell an adult working in the shop or a policeman etc
- 6. always go out with a friend
