**BEWARE: INCREASED TRAIN TRAFFIC CONTINUES**

Ongoing work to replace a major bridge near Bristol means high speed trains continue to be diverted via Gloucester until further notice.

Network Rail is asking families to continue to take extra care around level crossings in the area as ongoing work to replace a bridge for South Gloucestershire Council means an extended period of increased train traffic on our local railway lines.

Work continues to move the new bridge (which weighs more than 4,000 tonnes so requires the heaviest lift of its kind ever undertaken in the UK) into place, so passenger and freight trains between England and south Wales continue to be diverted via Gloucester. Network Rail is working around the clock to finish the work and get train services back to normal.
