## CORE VALUES



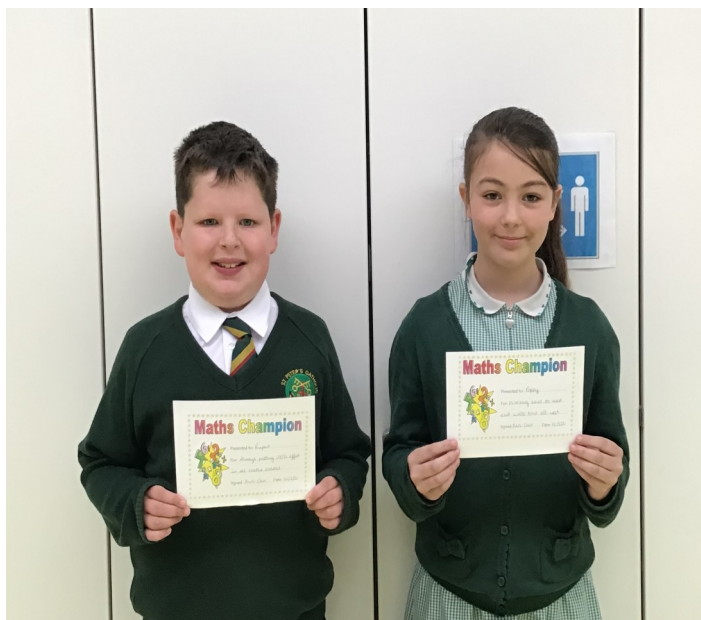
Our Core Value next term is HUMILITY— we shine when we show humility. We will help the children to recognise that:

Humility means thinking of ourselves less and others more.

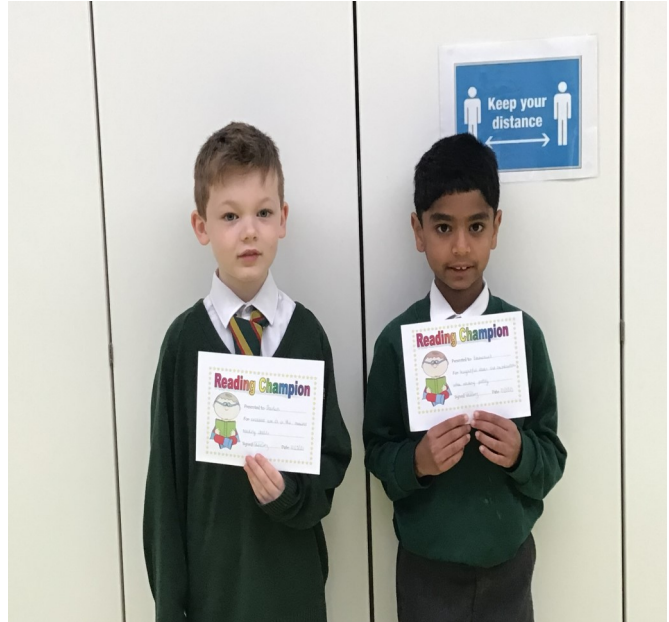

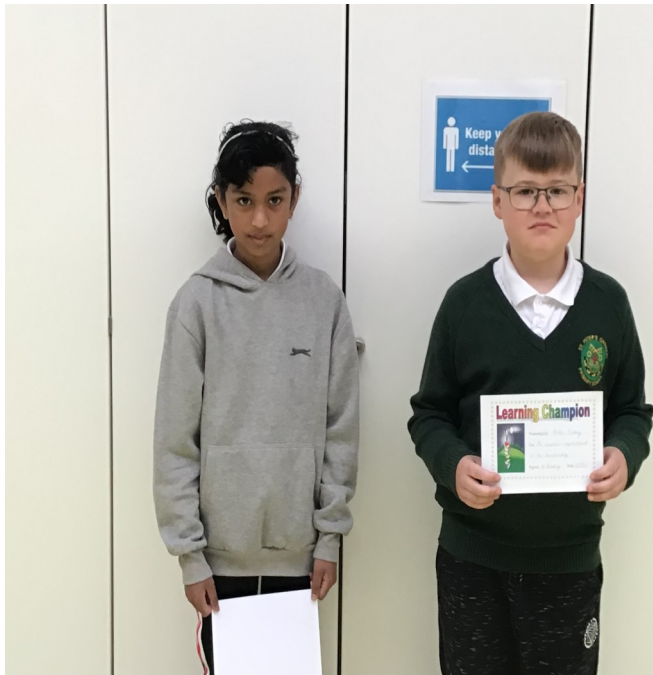

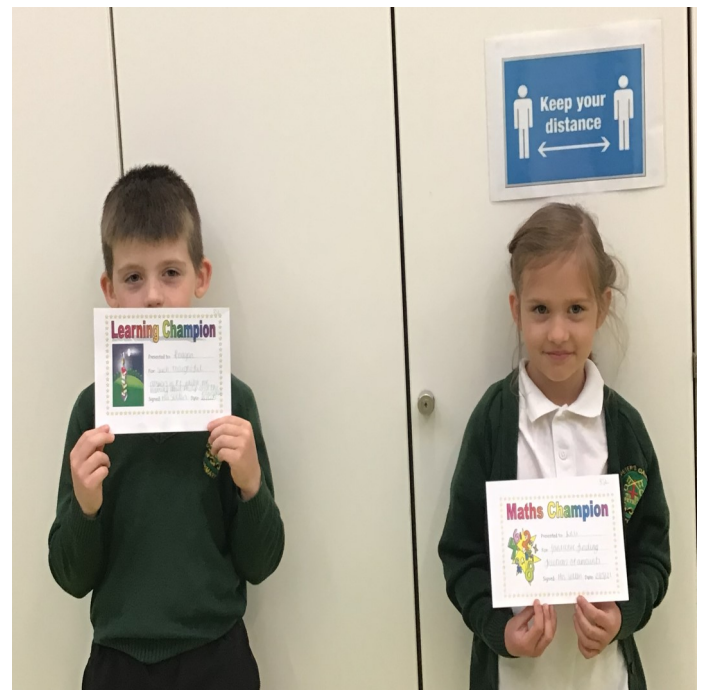

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

At a recent Governors' meeting, the Governors reviewed the school uniform policy.

They have agreed that on PE days children can wear a PE uniform to school instead of their school uniform.
