SPORTS DAY


that we will be going ahead with our school sports day this year. Children will need to come into school on Friday 16th July wearing their house colour t shirt, shorts and trainers.

COVID-19

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have created this flow chart to help you understand how to react to symptoms of Covid-19. The most important point to emphasise is that as soon as you/your child shows symptoms of Covid-19 you MUST self-isolate and get a PCR test. The lateral flow test is not to be used at this time.



Additional helpful information

LATERAL FLOW TEST

available for all parents and children to use if you wish to test regularly.

The Lateral flow will show if you are asymptomatic (you have CovId-19 without any symptoms)

DO NOT USE THIS METHOD IF ANYONE HAS SYMP-TOMS – GET A PCR TEST

SYMPTOMS OF COVID-19

- High temperature
- New continuous cough
- Loss/changing sense of taste or smell

For those who have been vaccinated,

SYMPTOMS may also include

- Headache
- Runny nose
- Sneezing

Dear Parents/Carers,

At the end of July we will be saying goodbye to 4 members of staff.

Mrs Brogan: Mrs Brogan has been a teacher and Early Years leader at St. Peter's for 16 years. During this time she has shaped the Early Years curriculum to ensure that it provides the right balance of play and learning to support the children's social and academic development. Mrs Brogan has ensured that all the children she has taught have good strong foundations on which other teachers can build upon and extend so that every child can reach their potential. During the 16 years, Mrs Brogan has also contributed significantly to the leadership of the school as a member of the Senior Leadership Team.

Mrs Dowding: Mrs Dowding is retiring at the end of July. She has been a teacher and the Key Stage 1 (KS1) leader at St. Peter's for 15 years. During this time, she has taught in both Y1 and Y2 and has shaped the next steps of the children's learning journey from the foundations set in Reception class. Most recently she has been instrumental in establishing a strong transition curriculum from Reception into Y1 which is now well embedded. During the 15 years, Mrs Dowding has also contributed significantly to the leadership of the school as a member of the Senior Leadership Team.

<u>Miss Hurley:</u> Miss Hurley is moving to a new school where she will be taking on the post of Early Years teacher. Miss Hurley has been with us for 4 years and has taught in Y1, Y2 and Y4 during this time.

Mrs Lawford: Mrs Lawford is moving to a new school where she will be taking on the post of Y3/4 teacher. Mrs Lawford has been with us for one year.

I am sure you will join me in wishing Mrs Brogan, Mrs Dowding, Miss Hurley and Mrs Lawford health and happiness for the future.

Free School Meal support this summer from Gloucestershire County Council

This summer, GCC is running two schemes for children eligible for Free School Meals.

Offer 1: Holiday Free School Meal vouchers

For the first and last week of the summer holiday only (26th – 30th July, and 30th August – 3rd September), parents who have signed up for holiday free school meal vouchers from the County Council will receive their voucher worth £15 per child per week to spend in a chosen supermarket.

A voucher for both weeks will be sent between the 14th to 16th July. You **do not need** to sign up to receive this voucher if you have received them in previous school holidays.

Offer 2: Holiday Activity and Food Programme (HAF)

Between the 2nd August and 27th August, GCC is co-ordinating the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme in partnership with district councils, the voluntary sector and other organisations. This programme is funded by the Department for Education (DfE).

This is a four-week programme of face-to-face activities in your local area, plus more virtual activities online, with daily meals or food kits being offered dependant on what is available in your district. Each district area (Cheltenham, Cotswolds, Forest of Dean, Gloucester, Stroud and Tewkesbury) will have its own separate section on our website for you to find what is happening in your area.

You must sign up to this programme in order to take part, and GCC will inform parents/carers and schools when applications open - please keep an eye out for it.

If you do not sign up to the HAF programme, you will not receive vouchers instead.
