

## Admission to St Peter's Catholic Primary School - Reception class September 2022

Starting School? If you have a child born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2017 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018, you will be able to apply for a place at our school for admission from September 2022. You must complete an application form that will be available from the school admissions team of Gloucestershire County Council from 4<sup>th</sup> November 2021. If your child is a baptised Catholic, you must also provide a copy of the baptism certificate to the school, even if you already have a child attending our school. Please ensure you apply by the closing date of 15<sup>th</sup> January 2022. We are offering tours of the school on the following dates: 22nd November 2021 at 5.30pm and 29th November 2021 at 2pm.
