Leaders In Faith

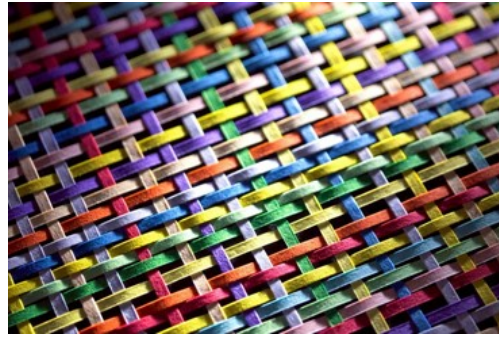
