#### School Dinners





Your child may be able to have free school dinners if you qualify for certain benefits.

#### Why should I apply?

For every child that is entitled to free school meals the school receives extra funding to enhance provision and improve progress and outcomes for children. So please apply even if you do not wish to take up your free school meal.

#### What are the qualifying criteria for Free School Meals?

Your child might be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Universal Credit - your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

Please <u>click here</u> to see if you are eligible. It doesn't take long, you only need your NI number plus your login details used when you applied for a primary school place, and you get an instant decision. Please remember that this is different to the free school meals that children get in Reception, Y1 and Y2 so it is still worth applying even if your child is in one of these year groups.
