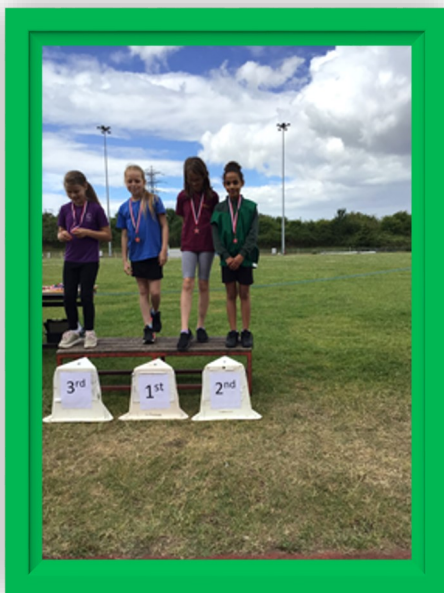
LEADERS IN FAITH
