### Gloucestershire Bundles

Gloucestershire Bundles is a charity providing emergency packs of toiletries, clothing and equipment to pregnant women and families with children up to the age of 16, who find themselves in crisis situations.

They are a referral only service and so only have direct contact with professional workers, such as Mrs Desando at School, Community Family Workers and Health Visitors.

## Olio

Olio is an app you can download that connects you with your neighbours so that surplus food and other household items can be shared, not thrown away. Everything on OLIO is available for free. Adding things to OLIO is easy. Simply snap a photo of your item, add a brief description and provide pick-up details. A lovely neighbour will be delighted to take it off your hands. Just browse what is available near you, request anything that takes your fancy and message to arrange a pick-up. It's as easy as that. Food items shared on OLIO include fresh homegrown veg from gardens, bread from local bakeries, and unwanted food when starting a diet, moving house or going on holiday. Other household items shared on OLIO include toiletries, cleaning products, clothes, furniture, toys and kitchen gadgets.

## Too Good to Go

Every day, delicious, fresh food goes to waste at cafes, restaurants, hotels, shops and supermarkets - just because it hasn't been sold in time. Too Good To Go lets you find and rescue this food so it gets eaten instead of thrown away. You won't know exactly what's in your order until you pick it up - it's all part of the surprise.
