**SCHOOL UNIFORM – OUR POLICY**

At St Peter's Catholic Primary School we take great pride in our school uniform as it is part of our identity. Our uniform is smart, functional, hardwearing, easy to obtain and maintain. All children are required to wear the school uniform and we appreciate your support in this matter.

Every item of clothing and all possessions brought to school should be clearly marked with your child's name. School uniform can be purchased from the uniform shop in Northgate Street, Gloucester but parents are not obliged to buy uniform from just this shop as items of the school uniform can be purchased from other shops/online.

The school uniform is as follows:

**JEWELLERY**

Your child is allowed to wear a watch to school but must remove this for PE lessons. If your child has pierced ears they may wear one pair of **small** studs. To protect your child, these must be removed before P.E. lessons. Your child is expected to remove and replace their own earrings. If your child cannot do this, then we ask parents to remove earrings before they come to school; staff cannot be responsible for removing or replacing earrings. If your child has just had their ears pierced then parents must cover their child's earrings with micro-porous or another suitable tape for 6 weeks. After the 6

week period, your child is expected to remove and replace their own earrings or you must remove your child's earrings on PE day.

**HAIR**

If your child has long hair it should be clipped or tied back. Two lengths of hair is acceptable, but the shortest should be a minimum of Grade 2. Mohican styles, shaved lines, tramlines, markings or patterns are not permitted. Excessive use of gel is not allowed. Coloured hair is not allowed.

**MAKE-UP, NAIL VARNISH and TRANSFERS** are not permitted.

**The school uniform is agreed and set by the Governors. Governors will meet with parents should there be a dispute about the uniform or where a family shows ongoing disregard to the school uniform policy.**
