

History

In History we are looking at changes within living memory by looking at the differences between our lives, our parents lives and our grandparents lives.

We will be focusing on and discussing how homes, phones, communication technology, transport and public transport have changed through time. We will also be exploring how entertainment has changed within the home.

R.E

This term, the children will be exploring the topic of Creation. We will be discussing and questioning who made our world and how God was able to make the world. We will be exploring psalms and understand how we use them to pray.

Children will learn to recognise some of the imagery used to speak of God in scripture and discuss the importance of sharing our thoughts and feelings with God through prayer.

P.E

In PE this term Year 1 will be following Real PE and will be looking primarily on our Personal Skills, with a physical focus on coordination and static balance. Children will learn to develop control, fluency and balance throughout these sessions.

English

In the first term, children will be building on work from the Early Years, focusing on phonics; blending and segmenting. We will be developing our love of reading by reading a range of texts and discussing lots of new vocabulary.

We will be learning how to spell words containing the phonemes we already know and will be focusing on writing simple sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Children will be looking at pencil grip, size, and the formation of letters.

Computing

This term, children will be looking at Online Safety; how to respect others online, protect their identities and create passwords.

Music

In Music this term we will be using Charanga to focus on listening to music and be able to comment on pitch, duration and tempo.

PSHE

This term our focus 'Being Me in My World', looking at our school community, working well with others and caring for others.

Art

Linked to our English text, we will be looking at using a range of materials to creatively design and make our own product.

Mathematics

This term our focus is on Number, looking carefully at place value within ten. We will be learning how to:

- ◆ Sort and count objects
- ◆ Count objects from a group of 10
- ◆ Represent objects
- ◆ Represent numbers to 10
- ◆ Count forwards and backwards
- ◆ Count one less
- ◆ One to one correspondence
- ◆ Compare objects

Year 1 AUTUMN TERM Changes Through Time

Science

In Science this term Year 1 will be focusing on the Seasons. We will be observing changes across the four seasons, describing weather associated with the seasons and looking carefully at how day length varies. We will be working scientifically by making tables and charts about the weather.
