Oracy success criteria

- Know what it is you want to talk about (Be clear about what you want to say)
- Voice and expression
- Include little details (This will make your speech more interesting)
- Humour (Including humour makes your speech memorable)
- Maintain eye contact (Keep looking ahead not at the floor or ceiling)
- Use your arms and hands (gesture, use your fingers to keep track of your speech)
- Smile (Enjoy what you are taking about)
- Lastly.....RELAX and ENJOY



BOYS' FOOTBALL NEWS!


