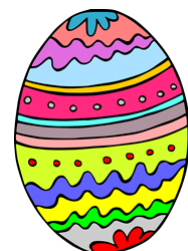
"I learnt that you can get arrested if you are carrying a knife for self-defence. You can also be arrested at the age of 10!" Da'nel, 6HC

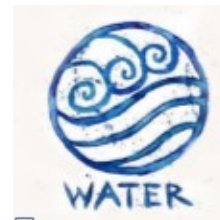
