

<u>Time for Secondary School</u>: Parents/carers of Year 6 children (born between 1 September 2012 and 31 August 2013), are reminded that **now** is the time to apply for their secondary school place for September 2024. To make your application:

you **must** complete the secondary transfer **application** form provided by your home Local Authority (available on the **LA** website) by 31 October, **and**:

if you are applying for a baptised child for any of the Catholic secondary schools listed below, you should **also** additionally complete their Supplementary Information Form (available on the **school's** website) and provide the school with a copy of your child's baptism certificate, also by 31 October.

St Joseph's Secondary School, Salisbury

Please note that all applicants **must** complete the Local Authority form – not just a school's supplementary form, and baptism certificates **must** be provided to the secondary school.
